Synod

Good morning and welcome to Church. It's great to have you here especially if you're new or visiting. We'd love to meet you after church over a cup of tea.

In last week's news article I gave an overview of what Synod is all about. This week I wanted to raise one of the keys issues that will be discussed this year.

In the lead up to Synod a report has been released titled, 'Attendance Patterns and Mission in the Diocese'. This report has been produced because of worrying statistics. In the last 10 years (2013-2023) attendance at Sydney Anglican Churches has declined by 7% or 14% if you take into account population growth over that period. That means simply, less people are going to church and our mission to reach people with the gospel appears to be going backwards rather than forwards.

There are many factors at play in this decline. Working out which ones are most significant is a difficult task. Australian society is becoming increasingly secular. This has been happening for much longer than the last 10 years but is clearly a significant factor. Some would suggest that this explains the decline. Others have suggested that perhaps we need to have a look at ourselves, perhaps we are not doing our job as the church as well as we should be or as well as previous generations have done.

Without committing to either option at the extent of the other, it does seem that thinking carefully about how we can do better is always a good thing to do. I'm not convinced that there will always be a direct line between faithfulness and numerical success but that's not a good reason to stop trying to do better. I'd be keen to hear from any of you who have reflections on this issue.

Is this a problem to be solved? Some would like to see a Diocese-wide strategy implemented to help churches get back on track. I'll be reporting back from Synod with what we come up with.
